- **Furnishings-** The majority of the properties that Platinum Property Management & Realty represent are fully furnished, which makes it easier for those shipping belongings from overseas. Fully furnished residences means that not only the furniture and appliances are supplied but some kitchenware and linens as well. In addition, a television will often come with the unit, but not always.
- **Pets-** Most residences within the Platinum Management Portfolio does not allow pets.
